

# INFORMATION FOR COMPETITORS

Dear competitor,

we would hereby like to give you information about the CVI Pezinok 2019, which will take place in town Pezinok from 13 to 16 June 2019.

## **Venue address**

## **Opening of the CVI + Chef d'Equipe Meeting**

We would like to kindly invite you to **Chef d'Equipe meeting and Opening event with catering and short culture program (7 persons per country invited)** on Thursday, **13 June at 18:00** in the meeting room at the Conference Building (see attached map).

## **Parking of cars and trailers is only allowed in the marked area**

Unload and upload of the horses is allowed only next to the Horses entrance. Your equipment boxes will be driven by a special OC-car to the stables. No competitors' car is allowed to enter the venue. **LKW parking area is next to the main entrance for horses, trailers will be parked inside the venue close to vaulting stables. See attached map.**

Please ask the driver of the OC-car to drive your boxes. Same procedure is also for the 16 June. Please inform the Show Office when you need the car at your departure.

## **Music**

Upload the music procedure:

- 1) go to <http://www.thinkfitt.eu/vaulting>
- 2) login (or register if you don't have an account yet)
- 3) you will find the folders you need (for example: compulsory, freestyle, entry)
- 4) select each map and upload your music (max 10 mb/file)

**You are welcome to come to music station in the competition hall and check your music during Thursday until 19:00.**

## **Entry fees:**

Entry fee may be paid in cash or via credit card upon your arrival.

Individuals	60,- EUR
Pas De Deux	60,- EUR
Stabling	190,-EUR including EADCMP, manure disposal, first bedding, for 3 nights from 13 to 16 June 2019.

OC will charge for every additional night 30,-EUR.

## **Additional fees:**

Material box: 100,- EUR  
Electricity: 40,- EUR.

All cars which buy electricity will get a sign that electricity was paid. There will be a random check of using the electricity.

## **Hay and straw**

There is a possibility to buy hay and straw in the barn close to the outside vaulting arena 30x50.

It has to be paid in the Financial Office (next to Show Office). You get a voucher and can pick up your order.

In any case of stabling problems or medical problems of competitors not happened in the competition circle call the Show Office.

Only Chefs d´Equipe are authorized to enter the Show Office.

Please let us know the phone number and e-mail address of your Chef `d Equipe.

Show Office will be open every day 30 minutes before first competition starts and 30 minutes after last competition.

### **Scoring Office:**

Results are available online at the [www.vaultingresults.com](http://www.vaultingresults.com) and are managed by Show Office. There is a free Wi-fi in the competition hall as well as in restaurant Rozalka, you can follow the results online.

### **Livestream:**

Please look at the map for the place where you can pick up your order. Opening hours are 14:00 – 18:00.

### **Starting Numbers**

We will charge € 5 bond for each armnumber. The bond has to be paid in cash in the Show Office and will be paid back after returning the armnumber.

### **Declaration of Starters**

Please declare the vaulters and their starting order on the horse **at the latest on Thursday, 13 June until 17:00 in the Show Office.**

### **Final**

CVI1\*/CVIJ1\*/CVICH1\*/CVICH2\* competitions are held in one round (including 1\* Pas de Deux). 50% of the individual starters of CVI2\* and CVIJ2\* are going to the final. Minimum 5 starters, maximum 20. All CVI2\*/CVIJ2\*/CVI3\* Pas De Deux, Individuals 3\* and all squads are going to the final as well.

### **Lost and Found**

If you lose or find anything during the competition at the venue, please contact the Show Office.

### **Emergency Number**

In case of life-threatening situation, not happens at the venue, call international rescue phone number 112.

### **Meals**

You can buy lunch and dinner at the Restaurant Rozálka directly at the venue, or use fast food stands.

### **Stabling**

#### **Horses are stabled in the outside wooden summer boxes.**

Stables are open from 06:00 to 22:00. After 22:00 please respect the night rest. Your horses will appreciate that. Stables are guarded during the whole night. In case of any health problems of your horse you will be contacted via the phone number you write on the nameplate of your horse on his stable.

The washing box is available next to the stable as well. Please follow all the security precautions. Smoking is strictly prohibited in the whole stabling and indoor competition area.

Only persons with the valid accreditation are allowed to enter the stables (max 3 persons per horse).

For the disposal of the manure, we provide a wheelbarrow, shovel and the pitchfork for your disposal. It will be placed next to the stable entrance.

### **Lunging and riding**

**Lunging** is allowed in the small riding hall and in the warm up circles of the competition arena as well. During the competition, two horses can be longed at warm up circles area and 3 additional horses can be led by hand in the competition arena. When coming from small indoor arena to the competition arena, please use the way leading outside the competition hall. (see attached map)

**For riding** you can use the outside arena 30x50. You can lead your horses at the lawn.

### **Horse Inspection**

The Horse Inspection will take place in the outside arena (30x50) on Thursday, 13 June at 15:00.

### **Official Training**

The Official Training in the competition circle is according sheet hanging at the competition arena, starting at 10:00 on Thursday, 13 June. You have to sign in to the sheet. Maximum 10 minutes per each horse are allowed at the competition circle.

### **Dogs**

Dogs are not allowed to enter the competition arena, in the outside area they have to be led on a leash.

### **Medical Service**

The ambulance will be parked next to the entrance of the competition arena. Medical Service will be available during every competition day one hour prior the first - until the end of the last competition.

### **Prize Giving Ceremony**

The Ceremony will take place in the competition arena on **Saturday (15<sup>th</sup> June) at 20:30** for individuals CVI1\*/CVIJ1\*/CVICH1\*/CVICH2\*+ Pas de deux CVI1\*/CVIJ1\*.

and **on Sunday, 16th June at 16:30** for individuals CVI2\*/CVIJ2\*/CVI3\*/Pas de deux CVI2\*/CVIJ2\*/CVI3\*/All Squads.

**On Sunday the Best horse** of the individual/pas de deux/squad competition will be awarded at the end of the Prize Giving Ceremony. These three horses are only horses which will take a part at the prize giving ceremony on Sunday. **No horses on Saturday.**

All participants (vaulters and lungers) will get a small gift from the OC through the Show Office.

All participants from the respective categories are invited to take a part at the ceremonies.

Rosettes will be distributed to all vaulters prior to the Prize Giving Ceremonies at the warm up circle.

Best 3 of each competition and category will be awarded with medals at the Prize Giving Ceremonies.

During the Prize Giving Ceremonies also lungers accompany the three best placed individual vaulters, pas-de-deux and squads.

The 3 best horses (individual/pas de deux/squad) will get special blankets. The Lungers will get these blankets before ceremony and we kindly ask you to put them on the horses.
